The sessions are designed to empower participants through positive thought, words, and actions, and feature inspirational speakers and activities! While highlighting the importance of community and girl power, each girl will also have an opportunity to participate in our community service care package project benefiting homeless youth.

Over the last three years, Girls Are Powerful, a 501(c)3 Organization, has been aggressively working to empower girls and inspire them to embrace their unique qualities. Through our collaborations with local schools and girl focused organization via our workshops, community events and special events, we have been able to carry out our overall vision to "support and create a generation of girls and young women, who are confident, maintain positive relationships, make positive decisions and exhibit responsible behaviors by embracing their power."

Your donation will help support our Community Service Care Package Project for homeless youth. Wilder Research reported that there is an estimated 6,000 Minnesota Youth who experience homelessness on an any given night. This includes an estimate of 2,500 minors age 17 and younger. These young people are often invisible and their voices are silent. These care packages will then be donated to an organization who provide these young people with the needed resources. Our goal is to have the attendees create 150 care packages that would include the following personal size toiletries items:

- Toothpaste
- Toothbrush
- Small Combs
- Lotion
- Deodorant
- Lip balm

- Individual Packs of Kleenex Small Wash Cloth
